Modern and spacious living

You will not be alone. Your one bedroom flat with your garden is one of five flats on the ground floor and there is a communal lounge and garden if you want to spend time with others, socialising and sharing interests.

Your support

We realise that what works for one person may not be right for another. With this in mind staff are recruited based on having the right values including being positive, creative and engaging. We match their skills, attitude and interests to yours.

We work with you (and your family if you wish us to) to identify things that are important to you.



Get involved

We believe in co-production where you are a decision maker and not a mere participant. You can therefore get involved in recruitment and choose your keyworker to develop a support plan based on the outcomes and goals you want to achieve.

Your team

The team is led by a Manager who is a BILD accredited Positive Behaviour Coach, a Non Abusive Physical and Psychological Intervention trainer and with experience in embedding the autism accreditation standards.

The team offers a support package that includes day support tailored to each individual's assessed need, with shared waking nights and sleep ins.

If you choose to live here, we will support you to live the life you want to live, with individual transition plans and opportunities that could include education, work opportunities, leisure, skill development and being part of the community.



Your staff's training and expertise

Staff are trained in autism, non abusive physical and psychological intervention, positive behaviour support, active support, intensive interaction, skill development, sensory needs assessments and total communication. A training plan is designed for staff based around each individual's specific requirements.

Their role is to support you to achieve your full potential.
