In brief

- Specialist 24 hour support provided to adults with learning disabilities and/or autism, who may also present with behaviours of concern.
- The property is a large detached house in a quiet residential area in Chingford containing five flats.
- Each self-contained flat has a bedroom, bathroom, an open plan sitting room and kitchen.
- The property has a communal sitting room, a sensory room and access to a large enclosed garden.
- Moments from Epping Forest and close to Chingford Golf Course.
- Short walking distance to local shops, pubs, restaurants, medical centres, banks, post office and Chingford Library.
- Near to a cinema, swimming pool, leisure facilities and places of worship.
- Transport links are excellent – close to a number of local buses and the Chingford overground station with its route to Liverpool Street.
- Westfield shopping centre, Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park and Leyton Orient football club are all accessible by public transport.

The Drive is a supported living scheme tailored to provide personalised services to adults with learning disabilities and/or autism who may also present with behaviours of concern.

The management have health and social care qualifications and vast knowledge and experience working with people with autism.

Our team of fully trained staff deliver individual support packages to meet the needs of each person, as they wish to be supported. Staff are trained in autism spectrum disorder, non abusive physical and psychological intervention, positive behaviour support, active support, communication with people with learning disabilities, skills development, sensory needs assessments and many other relevant disciplines.

A training plan is designed for each individual's specific requirements.

The service encourages long term achievements, goals and aspirations. We promote skills teaching to maximise the potential of each person and to build confidence and self-esteem. We encourage individuals to take part in a wide range of activities and try new experiences.



Individuals and their families have the opportunity to self-direct their support and contribute to how the service will be delivered.

The model of support at The Drive provides each person with one to one support during the day.

It also provides a core support of sleep in/waking night staffing as part of each support package.
